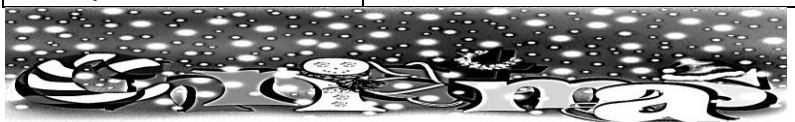

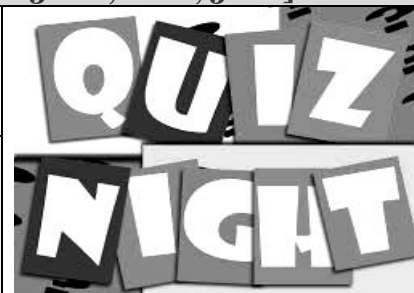
Quizzes

Membership

Single Membership is currently £15 per annum and Joint Membership (for couples) is £25. New members also pay a £5 joining fee (includes the cost of a fob).
