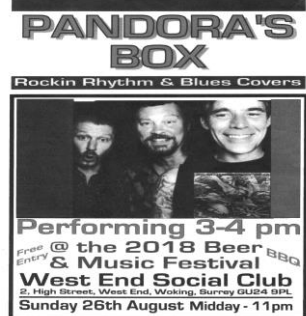
Large Portion (Saturday 2nd March 2019)

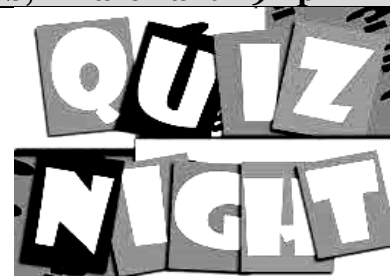
Internet: There is free wireless internet access available all day for members in the club lounge.(code: **4346a9c43c**)
